

Hope's Fingerless Gloves

These were pretty much completely improvised because I just couldn't find a fingerless glove pattern I liked. They're a gift for a swap buddy, so I wanted them to be nice, but didn't have a lot of time to spend. I wanted cables, but I didn't want them to be overwhelming (due to tight deadline). I wanted them to be simple, but I wanted an actual thumb. So I looked through every fingerless glove pattern I could find and then used parts and pieces from all the patterns I liked.

Size

Fits a woman's medium-sized hands

Stitch Directions

c4f - cable 4 to the front. Put 2 stitches on a cable needle and hold in front of work (toward you). Knit the next two stitches, then knit the two stitches off the cable needle.

Pattern

CO 32 stitches and distribute evenly across 3 DPNs

Knit 6 rows 1x1 rib (k1, p1)

Row 1: (k10, p1, c4f, p1) twice

Row 2: (k10, p1, k4, p1) twice

Repeat rows 1 and 2 four times.

Row 3: k1, m1, k1, k6, m1, k2, complete row continuing cable pattern as established

Repeat row 3 every other row until there are 44 stitches on needles.

Row 4: k6, place next 10 st on holder, k6, complete row continuing cable pattern as established

Complete 2 more whole cables (12 rows), finishing with a cabled row.

Knit 4 rows 1x1 rib

Bind off hand

Move thumb stitches from stitch holder onto needles and pick up 2 st from side of hand for 12 total and distribute evenly across 3 DPNs.

Knit 6 rows straight.

Knit 3 rows 1x1 rib

Bind off thumb.

Materials

2 skeins Moda Dea Cartwheel
in Bronzeberry
4 US8 DPNs

Waste yarn or stitch holders

Gauge

Approx. 17.0 = 4 inches
